

**TOWN OF AURORA**  
**MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING**  
Thursday, February 12, 2026

The Aurora Town Board met at the town hall on Thursday, February 12, 2026. Officers present were Chairman CJ Young, Supervisor I Jeff Toll, Treasurer Melissa Zamzow, and Clerk Ann Mosling. County District Supervisor Tom Mosling was also present.

The Chairman called the monthly meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

**Business:**

1. Discussion with possible decision to change Emergency Medical Services (EMS) from City of Berlin to Waushara County – *Andy requested that this issue be postponed until next month's meeting when he is available*
2. **A motion was made by CJ, and seconded by Jeff, to approve the 2026 Ahern Fire Alarm Inspection contract for \$310.00. Motion carried.** CJ signed the contract.
3. An invoice sent to a resident to charge \$100 to replace owner's fire sign remains unpaid from June'25 (the town pays for the original fire sign, but all replacements are charged to the property owner.) Ann was directed to follow procedure by submitting the unpaid invoice to the county as a Special Assessment, where the assessed value is charged to the owner's property tax.
4. Road report and any necessary decisions pertaining to maintenance and improvement.
  - Current projects:
    - i. Trim trees overgrowing Cumberland Ave (\$10K budget). *Trees are marked but uncut. Contractor will cut until \$10K is reached.*

- ii. CJ meeting with county highway dept to complete WISLR local road certification packet. *Completed*
- iii. Get quotes for 37<sup>th</sup> cutoff road for Aug/Sept timeframe. *Eligible for LTRP funds – apply this year thru county*

Future projects:

- Blacktop town hall parking lot and repair storm drainage *WEC election audit rpt requirement*
  - Next year's seal coating projects / crack fill before seal coating if we have the money:
    - o E. Waushara – from Retzlaff's to top of the hill, approximately 1 mile
    - o Side streets off of E. Waushara
    - o 32<sup>nd</sup> Dr (road to Walmart): ditching, need quote on overlay, roadway sagging at culvert (culvert itself verified OK)
    - o Cypress -- Fill crossline cracks to prevent dipping
    - o Cut-off road to Walmart
5. **A motion was made by Jeff, and seconded by CJ, to approve the scheduled payments. Motion carried.**

As there was no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:46 pm.
